

Mobile Phones & Earphones

AWAY FOR THE DAY

The New Zealand Government has made it compulsory that mobile phones must not be seen or used by students during the school day. Therefore, One Tree Hill College have the following expectations of all students:

Expectations

Mobile phones and/or headphones/ear buds are not to be used or seen at any time during the school day. The only exception to this is as below. 'Use' includes playing music, using the internet (inc. apps), texting, phone calls, filming/photographing etc.

Mobile phones and headphones/ear buds are not to be used from the start of Period 1 until the end of the school day. This includes break times (interval and lunch).

Mobile phones may only be used under the explicit permission and instruction of a teacher for direct teaching and learning purposes.

In an urgent scenario, if a student needs to use a phone during the school day they must seek permission of a Whānau Leader or AP/DP or they can seek permission to use the telephone in the Student Services Centre.

If a student is not meeting these expectations these items will be confiscated by a staff member.
